2. Mr.Joshi, learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions, seeks liberty to withdraw this first appeal unconditionally.
3. First appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. Office is directed to transmit the statutory deposit of Rs.25,000/- if not transmitted so far to the concerned MACT expeditiously. Refund of Court fees, if any, as per rules. The appellant is directed to convey this order to the respondents' advocate.

of this Court. If there is any shortfall in recovering the decretal amount, the appellant would be at liberty to execute the decree in respect of the balance amount. If there is any surplus left after making payment of decretal amount by the appellant, the same shall be refunded to the appellant on production of authenticated copy of this Court. Parties as well as the executing Court to act on the authenticated copy of this order.
