2. Heard learned counsel for parties. By this Appeal, appellant/ Insurance Company is challenging Judgment and Award dated 24.1.2017 passed by MACT, Satara in MACP no.65/2014 holding that respondent/claimants are entitled sum of Rs.13,24,000/- by way of compensation with 9% interest p.a.

3 Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the Court below failed to consider the fact that, the driver of the offending vehicle was negligent and therefore, his motor cycle colluded with Tata qualis.
