2 By this Civil Application, applicant is seeking condonation of 131 days delay in filing First Appeal challenging the order dated 26/03/2014 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal at Nashik in

Motor Accident Claim Petition No. 711 of 2009.

3 Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant and the averments made in the Civil Application, I am satisfied that applicant has made out a case for allowing the Civil Application. Hence, following order:

(I) Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a) which reads thus:
