The learned counsel for the Applicant submits that by the Civil Revision Application Defendant No.1 challenges the order dated 09.04.2012 passed by the Additional Judge, Small Causes Court and Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Pune rejecting their Application u/s.9A of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
