1 The applicant in Civil Application No. 1630 of 2019 has prayed for condoning the delay of 3 days in making the payment. 4 It is stated across the bar that the proceedings have reached the stage of final hearing. In view of this, the learned Family Court No. 2, Pune is hereby requested to conclude the proceedings within 3 months.
