1] The learned Counsel for the Petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent of prayer clause (a) of the Petition, which reads thus :-

“a) This Hon'ble Court may direct to the Respondent No.1 to hear & decide the Revision Application filed by the Petitioner along with stay Application as early as possible not beyond the 2 months challenging the Order dated 11/08/2016 passed by Addl. Commissioner, Pune Division, Pune in No. RTS/KOLHAPUR/REV/183/2011.”

2] Petitioner has not pressed other prayers in the Petition.

3] Petition, as such, stands disposed of in terms of prayer clause (a). Time to hear and decide the Revision Application along with Stay Application shall be of four months instead of two months. As far as prayer for extension of interim relief is concerned, status quo operating as of date shall continue till the decision of the proceedings as ordered hereinabove.
