1 The applicant/original petitioner seeks restoration of Writ
Petition (Stamp) No. 34721 of 2017. It appears that because of
conditional order passed by the Registrar (Judicial-I) on 17th
September 2018, the petition has been dismissed for non-removal of
office objections.

2 The respondents in this situation, fairly left it to Court to pass suitable orders. Counsel for applicant submits that if petition is restored, within one week, all objections will be removed.
