1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. The petitioner is a resident of Jalgaon and he is basically challenging the order passed by respondent No.2-Schedule Tribe Certificate Scrutiny Committee at Nandurbar. In that view of the matter, we are of the opinion, that this petition should lie before the Aurangabad Bench of this Court.
3. Mr. Mendadkar, learned counsel for the petitioner, having taken instructions from his client who is present before the Court, faced with the above difficulty, seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty

to file a fresh petition before the Aurangabad Bench of this Court. Leave with liberty as prayed for, is granted. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
