Heard Mr. Sud, petitioner in person and Mr. Kadam, learned A.G.P, for respondents No.1 and 2.

2. The matter was heard on 28th January, 2019. After considering the prayers made in the Petition, it was indicated to the petitioner that the Court is not inclined to entertain this Petition. During the course of the hearing, Mr. sud sought leave to amend so as to challenge the judgment and decree dated 28th August, 2013 passed by the learned trial Judge in R.A.D. Suit No.264 of 2013 as also execution in pursuance of that decree.
