2 In Crime No. 611/2018 registered with Chaturshrungi Police Station, Pune for offence punishable under Sections 384, 385, 389 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, applicant is seeking pre-arrest bail. Offence is registered pursuant to the order passed by the Magistrate in a proceedings taken out by the complainant under section 156 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

3 Perused contents of F.I.R. *Prima facie*, the dispute between the parties appears to be civil in nature which pertains transfer of movable property and the right of the applicant to transfer the same.

4 Admittedly, civil dispute in relation to property referred to in the complaint is already pending.

5 The contents of the F.I.R. does not reflect the necessity of

custodial interrogation. That being so, Ad-interim order passed by this Court on 18/12/2018 stands confirmed.
