1. The Official Assignee holds certain shares that are in the name of the Insolvent. They are in physical form. They are to be converted to Demat form. A demat account will be required. For this purpose, the Official Assignee will need the services of a broker. The names of four brokers are listed in the Official Assignee's Report. All four brokers are on the panel of the Court Receiver, High Court, Bombay.
