1. Perused the order dated 3rd May, 2019. The learned Advocate for the Respondent states that he has received a scanned copy of the Vakalatnama signed by the Director of the Respondent Company. He states that he has instructions from the parent company of the Respondent as well as from the Director of the Respondent to inform the Court that they have no objection if time granted is extended to enable the learned Arbitrator to decide the disputes between the parties and to pass his Award.
