1) This Chamber Summons has been filed by the plaintiffs seeking an amendment of the plaint as per Schedule annexed thereto. This amendment is necessitated in view of the fact that “Rabo India Finance Limited” is merged with “Rabo India Securities Private Limited”. It is, in these circumstances, that the amendment is sought to substitute the name of “Rabo India Finance Limited” with that of “Rabo India Securities Private Limited” as well as the consequential amendments thereto.

2) The learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Plaintiff has tendered an affidavit of service dated 11th January, 2019 evidencing service of the Chamber Summons on all the defendants.

3) Considering the nature of the amendment sought and for the reasons stated in the affidavit in support of the Chamber Summons, the same is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (a) and (b). The Amendment to be carried out within a period of three weeks from today and an amended copy of the plaint shall be served upon the defendants or their Advocates

within a period of two weeks thereafter.
