1 Heard the learned Counsel for the respective parties.

2 It is stated by the writ petitioner that he has preferred
an appeal bearing Appeal No.87 of 2019 along with stay
application before the Respondent No.3 i.e. Divisional Joint
Registrar. He further asserted that hearing of the stay application
was held by the said Authority on 19th March 2019 and till date no
interim order has been passed.

3 The learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that
since bank accounts of the petitioners have been frozen by the

impugned Order passed by the respondent No.2, the working of the Society has become standstill.
