. After the last order in the matter was passed (i.e. on 18 December 2018), the SLP of Respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4 has been dismissed by the Supreme Court. This Court is informed that since the dismissal of the SLP, an arbitral tribunal of three arbitrators has been constituted and is seized of the reference.
