1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. By this Chamber Summons, the applicant is seeking to carry out amendment in the Writ Petition No.605 of 2015 in view of the subsequent development.
3. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the applicant and affidavit filed in support of the

chamber summons, we are satisfied that the applicant has made out a case for allowing this chamber summons. Hence, the following order.

a) Chamber summons is allowed in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:
