1. The Chamber Summons is filed for permission to be granted to the Plaintiffs to amend the Plaint and Notice of Motion No. 2344 of 2010 as per the schedule annexed to the Chamber Summons. The learned Counsel for the Applicant states that on account of subsequent events including the handing over the property to the Respondent by the Defendant, which have taken place after the filing of the Suit, it would be necessary to carry out relevant amendment to the Suit as well as Notice of Motion by bringing on record the Respondent as Defendant No.2 as well as

consequential amendment. There is no opposition to the Chamber Summons and accordingly the Chamber Summons is made absolute in terms of prayer clause (a). The amendment shall be carried out within a period of two weeks from the date of this order.

The Applicants are permitted to carry out the amendment to the schedule to the Chamber Summons forthwith.
