1] Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent.

2] This is a petition filed under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short called as, "the Act"), whereby the petitioner prays for extension of the mandate of the arbitral tribunal to conclude the arbitral proceeding and publish an award.

3] It is informed that the witnesses on behalf of the petitioner have already been examined. Learned counsel for the respondent states that the respondent would be examining only 2 to 3 witnesses. Learned counsel for the respondent would also agree that the evidence on behalf of all parties would be completed at the earliest. Accordingly the mandate of the arbitral
