1. Mr.Maravoor for the applicant tenders draft amendment to the plaint which is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification. One of the amendment sought is to add 17 persons as defendants. One of them to be added as defendant no.45 is the applicant in this chamber summons.

2. Mr.Maravoor for plaintiffs has no objection if the amendment prayed for is granted because that will work out the

Chamber summons as well. Ms.Rohira for defendant nos.1 to 8 also has no objection for granting the amendment subject to rights and contentions of defendant nos.1 to 8 being kept open.
