1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties. By this notice of motion, the applicant seeks condonation of delay of 20 days in filing the arbitration petition. The applicant has explained the delay in paragraphs 6 to 11 of the affidavit in support of the notice of motion. There is no substance in any of the objections raised by the respondent in the affidavit in reply. The delay is sufficiently explained by the applicant in the affidavit in support of the notice of motion.
