2. Upon perusal of the same, it is evident that the Slum Rehabilitation Authority has withdrawn its stop work notice.
3. In the light of the fact that the stop work notice has been withdrawn with liberty reserved in favour of the Slum Rehabilitation Authority nothing further survives in the Notice of Motion and it is disposed of.
4. In so far as the other prayers in the Notice of Motion are concerned, we keep open all the contentions of the petitioners before us.
5. The attempt to intervene is also not upheld in the light of the communication from the Slum Rehabilitation Authority. The intervenors’ right are, therefore, always protected and do not get in any manner affected by this order.
6. The Notice of Motion is disposed of.
