C.A. NO.196/2019

This is an application praying for recalling of the order dated 24.07.2018 and directing to strike off the name of the respondent no.4 from the array of respondents. The learned Advocate for applicant submits that since the appellant/applicant was not aware about the names of legal heirs of respondent no.4 the order for striking off the names of respondent no.4 from the array of respondents was passed by this Court. She further submitted that she had already filed an application requesting the other respondents to give the details of the legal heirs of respondent no.4.
