By this application, the applicant seeks permission to amend the memorandum of revision to add certain grounds. The applicant has also sought permission to amend the prayer clauses of the memorandum of revision. The proposed amendments to the prayer clauses show that the applicant is seeking to add two prayer clauses which are already existing in the memorandum of revision. It is not pointed out why same prayers which exist in the memorandum of revision are being sought to be incorporated again. The facts show that the civil application is filed mechanically. Such amendment cannot be permitted. Civil application is **dismissed** with costs quantified at Rs.2,000/- (Two Thousand) to be paid by the applicant to the non-applicant No.2. The amount of costs shall be paid and
