Today, I have dismissed Writ Petition No. 2699/2019 and have maintained the orders passed by the subordinate authorities disqualifying the petitioner under Section 14 (1) (j-3) of the Maharashtra Village Panchayats Act on the ground that the petitioner is residing in house constructed on government / gram panchayat land.

In this petition, the orders passed by the subordinate authorities disqualifying the petitioner under Section 14 (1) (j-3) of the Act of 1958 for encroaching over the government / village panchayat land/road are challenged.

In view of the fact that disqualification of the petitioner is upheld in Writ Petition No. 2699/2019, the challenges in this petition have become academic. Hence, without delving into the issues raised in this petition, the petition is **dismissed** as infructuous. In the circumstances, the parties to bear their own costs.
