Heard learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 1 to 4 as well as learned counsel for the appellant.

Perused the application as well as impugned judgment and award, it appears that respondent Nos. 2 to 4 are minors, and therefore, their share amount cannot be permitted to withdraw. The respondent No.1 is entitled to withdraw  $\frac{1}{4}^{\text{th}}$  amount deposited by the appellant on filing usual undertaking to the effect that, she shall refund the said amount in case appeal is allowed.
