Order dated 21.1.2019 would reveal that after interviewing applicant no.1 and non-applicant no.2, matter was adjourned for today for parties to come to some amicable settlement, with reference to amount of permanent alimony to be paid to non-applicant no.2. Learned counsel for non-applicant no. 2, on instructions, makes a statement that she is ready to accept reasonable amount whatsoever is paid to her.
