1. This is an application taken out by the respondent-wife for permission to withdraw the amount of Rs. 1,20,000/- deposited by the petitioner-husband.

2. However, both the learned counsel state that dispute is amicably resolved. It is agreed that the amount of Rs. 1,20,000/- as deposited by the petitioner-husband shall be withdrawn not by the wife but by the petitioner-husband who shall then pay the wife amount of Rs. 5,50,000/- out of which Rs. 2,00,000/- is already paid.

3. In view of the amicable settlement, the respondent-wife is not pressing this application.

4. The application is disposed of.

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. In view of the amicably settlement of the dispute, this petition is disposed of by mutual consent.

2. The amount of Rs. 1,20,000/- which is deposited by the petitioner-husband may be withdrawn by the petitioner-husband.
