Heard learned Advocate Shri Motwani for the applicant. Copy of the FIR is not filed on record. He has pointed out that say filed by Assistant Public Prosecutor before the Additional Sessions Judge, Bhandara.

2. From the perusal of order passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Bhandara, it is clear that motorcycle used in the crime is to be seized. Custodial interrogation of the accused is necessary. Offences punishable under Sections 376, 363 and 506 of IPC are serious in nature.
