2. The petitioners are permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal.

3. By way of interim order dated 29<sup>th</sup> May 2019, this Court had directed the petitioners to deposit an amount of Rs. 24 lakhs with the respondent no.2 and an amount of Rs. 5 lakhs was directed to be deposited in this Court on or before 10<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

4. The petitioners have deposited an amount of Rs. 5 lakhs in this Court and an amount of Rs. 13 lakhs with the respondent no.2-financial institution.

5. The respondent no.2 is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.5 lakhs deposited in this Court. We continue the interim order passed by this Court for a further period of fifteen days from today and the deposit of the balance amount shall be the condition precedent for DRAT to entertain the Appeal. All questions are left open.
