By this application, the respondents – claimants pray that the appellant – Corporation be directed to deposit the balance amount as per the impugned award.

By the order dated 11/01/2017, after hearing the advocates for the appellant - Corporation and respondent – claimants, this Court passed reasoned order directing the appellant – Corporation to deposit 60% of the amount of compensation within 12 weeks from the date of the order. Accordingly, the appellant – Corporation has deposited the amount.

Considering the fact that reasoned order came to be passed on 11/01/2017 on the point, in our view, the prayer made in this application cannot be considered, at this stage.

Hence, the civil application is **dismissed**.

CIVIL APPLICATION (F) NO. 2385/2019

By the order dated 11/01/2017, this Court permitted the claimants to withdraw 50% of the amount on furnishing solvent surety/security.

By this application, the respondents – claimants have prayed that they be permitted to withdraw the amount deposited by the appellant – Corporation as per the order dated 11/01/2017.

In view of the order dated 11/01/2017, the prayer made in this civil application by the respondents – claimants seeking permission to withdraw the entire amount deposited by the appellant – Corporation cannot be granted.

The respondents – claimants will be at liberty to withdraw 50% of the amount on furnishing solvent surety/security as permitted by the order dated 11/01/2017.

With the above observations, the civil application is **dismissed**.
