Learned AGP Ms. Naik has submitted that legal heirs of deceased respondent nos. 1-A to 1-H. There may be dispute between the parties in respect of the Will. At this stage, only on the basis of will only the respondent Chamfabai (only) can not be taken on record. All the legal heirs are to be taken on record.

Looking to the grounds mentioned in the applications, the applications are allowed.

All the legal heirs of respondent no. 1 i.e. respondent nos. 1-A to 1-H brought on record within the period of two weeks.
