It is pointed out that departmental enquiry was initiated against respondent No.5-Swapnil Tayade and punishment is inflicted on him and appeal filed by him is also dismissed. The learned Advocate for the respondent No.5 stated that further appeal is provided before the Director General of Police and the respondent No.5 has filed it.

The Director General of Police is directed to decide the appeal filed by the respondent No.5-Swapnil Tayade and place copy of the order on record of this petition till 30th January 2020.
