By this application, the claimants seek permission to withdraw the amount of compensation as deposited.

The application is opposed by the learned counsel for the appellant/non-applicant.

Perused the impugned judgment. Considering the nature of evidence on record, the claimants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount of compensation as deposited. The non-applicant no.1 shall file an undertaking within eight weeks stating therein that in case the appeal is allowed, the amount withdrawn shall be re-deposited with interest at such rate the Court may direct. Remaining amount shall be invested in Fixed Deposit.
