Pathan, learned A.P.P. states that the grievance of the petitioner does not survive in as much as Section 201 of the Indian Penal Code is added in the crime registered against the accused, Statement of Vishal Daherwal under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is recorded and the role of suspect Shubham Tiwari in the crime is examined and it is found that he is not involved in the crime.
