1. Heard learned counsel Shri A.C.Jaltare for the applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor Shri N.R.Rode for the State. Also, perused reply filed on behalf of the State.
2. The applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No.186/2019 registered with Armori Police Station, District Gadchiroli for offences under Sections 65(a) and 83 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act.
3. As per the prosecution case, the applicant fled away from vehicle which was having liquor worth Rs.2,02,800/-.
4. District Gadchiroli is a dry district wherein possession, transportation, and selling of liquor is banned.
5. Record shows that as many as 42 offences are registered against the present applicant in various police

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stations. That shows that the applicant has inclination to jump bail and he is a repeater.

6. In this view of the mater, the present applicant does not deserve any consideration. Hence, the criminal application is rejected and disposed of accordingly.

7. It is made clear that if the applicant surrenders and/or is arrested by police authorities and if the applicant files an application for grant of regular bail before competent Court, competent Court shall keep in mind that the applicant has tendency and inclination to jump bail granted to him.
