Heard Mr. Patil, learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Ghodeswar, learned A.P.P. for State.

Present appeal is against judgment and order of conviction passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pusad in Sessions Trial No.111/1997, by which the Court below has convicted the appellant for an offence punishable under Section 304-II of the Indian Penal Code.

This appeal was admitted on 04.12.2006 and the appellant was released on bail.

Paper book is also ready. However, the learned A.P.P. Mr. Ghodeswar filed a Pursis Stamp No.809/2019, wherein it is stated that as per written instructions received from Police Station Officer, Police Station, Umarkhed, it is stated that the appellant Vitthal Sambhaji Shinde has expired on 18.05.2009.
