Shri Kanungo, learned Counsel for applicants, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the criminal application and further prays that direction may be issued to learned trial Court to decide expeditiously application filed under Section 156 of Code of Criminal Procedure upon which Police report is stated to be received by submitting that due to pendency of the present application, said application is kept pending before learned trial Court.
