This is an application seeking permission to file undertaking and solvent surety in terms of order dated 22/04/2019, whereby the respondents No.1 to 6 were permitted to withdraw the amount. The solvent surety and undertaking were supposed to be filed within 4 weeks from 22/4/2019, but, the same could not have filed within stipulated period. The learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 6 (applicants) informs that now the solvent surety as well as undertaking is ready for filing.
