After hearing the learned Advocate for the application Nos.1 to 3 (accused) and applicant No.4 (informant) and *prima facie*, examining the material on record and copy of charge-sheet which is shown at the time of hearing, we are not inclined to grant the prayer made in this criminal application for quashing First Information Report and charge-sheet. The record reveals that the applicant No.3 (accused) was absconding till filing of the charge-sheet.

On query, the learned advocate for the accused, on instructions, states that the applicant No.3 is reported to be represented but he has not surrendered.

In the above facts, we see no reason to exercise extraordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Hence, the criminal application is **dismissed**.
