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**ORDER**

**(Passed on 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2019)**

1] The parties with their counsel state that they have settled the claim and the terms of compromise have been placed in writing which is marked as "X" for identification.

2] Parties have amicably settled the matter and it is agreed that the respondent no. 1 – Insurance Company would pay Rs. 2,25,000/- to the appellants/claimants in addition to already paid amount i.e. Rs. 1,00, 000/- to the appellants/claimants.

3] It is stated on behalf of the Insurance Company that the remaining amount of Rs. 2, 25,000/- will be deposited within 60 days from the date of this order which the claimants would be entitled to withdraw, if already not withdrawn.

4] If the respondent no. 1 – Insurance Company fails to pay the remaining amount, it will be liable to pay interest @ 9% per annum from the date of this order.

5] Court fee, if any, be refunded to the appellants as per the Rules.

6] There is no reason to refuse this compromise. Hence, the matter stands **disposed of** in terms of compromise Pursis 'X'.
