Record reveals that on earlier two dates, this petition was adjourned on the request of learned Counsel for petitioner since it was stated that issue involved herein is amicably settled and petitioner wants to place on record terms of compromise. In that view of the matter, petition is dismissed with liberty in favour of petitioner to contest “C” summary proceedings before trial Court.
