Applicant approaches to this Court in its jurisdiction under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for pre-arrest bail, after rejection of his pre-arrest bail application at the hands of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Akola.

Perused the first information report. A specific role is attributed to the present applicant in respect of strangulation.
