It is natural on the part of applicant to beat the deceased. Hence, the applicant is entitled for bail. Hence, following order.

[i] The application is allowed.

[ii] The applicant be released on bail on furnishing PR bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one solvent surety in like amount on following conditions.

[a] The applicant shall cooperate in the investigation.

[b] The applicant shall not tamper the evidence of prosecution.

- [c] The applicant shall attend the trial Court on each and every date.
- [d] The applicant shall not leave the jurisdiction of trial Court without prior permission.
- [e] The breach of any condition amounts to cancellation of bail.
