While allowing the claim petition the Railway Claims Tribunal directed that some amount receivable by the petitioners be kept in fixed deposit for the period of five years. Before expiry of the period of five years, the petitioners filed an application before the Tribunal seeking permission to withdraw the amount. This application is dismissed by the impugned order.

I find that the Tribunal has rightly appreciated the facts and the reasons recorded by the Tribunal in the penultimate paragraph of the impugned order, cannot be faulted with. Hence, I see no reason to interfere with the impugned order.
