In view of the submission of the learned senior counsel Shri Anand Jaiswal who appears on behalf of respondents 6 and 7 that the petitioners have an alternate statutory remedy, the learned counsel for the petitioners Shri S.G. Jagtap states on instructions that the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to take recourse to the statutory remedy.
