4] The learned ASGI Shri Ulhas Aurangabadkar is also requested to extend his cooperation in the matter.

5] Copy of this order be supplied to the learned ASGI.

6] In view of the decision of the Supreme Court in *Mallikarjun Kodagali (dead) represented through Legal Representatives v. State of Karnataka & Ors.* reported in 2018(14) Scale 32, it would not be necessary for the appellant – who is father of the deceased – to seek leave.

7] This application is disposed of.

8] The appeal be registered.

9] Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 01.07.2019.
