The crime is of the year 2015, now, almost four years have been lapsed and hence, due to the lapse of period, the prayer sought for by the petitioner cannot be considered now.

3.Considering the long pendency of the case, the 5th respondent is hereby directed to complete the investigation in Crime No.279 of 2015 and file a final report within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this Order, before the jurisdictional Magistrate, if not already filed.

4.With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.

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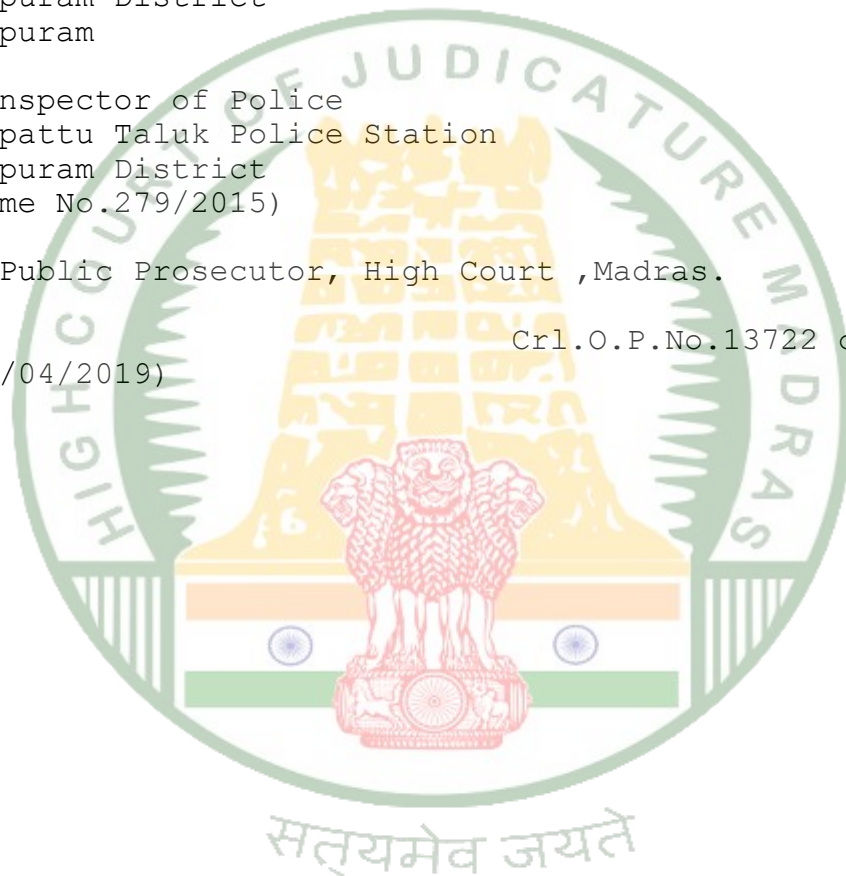
