The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention dated 17.12.2018 in order D.O.No.53/2018-C-2, detaining her sister as "Bootlegger", as contemplated under Section 2 (b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

order of detention passed against the detainee has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.450 Home, Prohibition & Excise (XI) Department, dated 07.02.2019 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.
