O R D E R

This petition has been filed seeking a direction, directing to the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Coimbatore to consider and pass orders on their bail application on the very same day in the event of the petitioners surrendering before the Court and filing bail application in connection with the Crime No.314 of 2018, pending on the file of the Inspector of Police, Vadavalli Police Station, Coimbatore District.

2.In view of the amendments made in the Scheduled Caste and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, this Court is of the view that the usual directions that were issued by this Court cannot be issued routinely in all cases. Therefore, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such surrender, the learned Special Judge shall deal with the matter on the same day on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the victims under Section 15 (A) of the SC/ST Act.

3. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above directions.

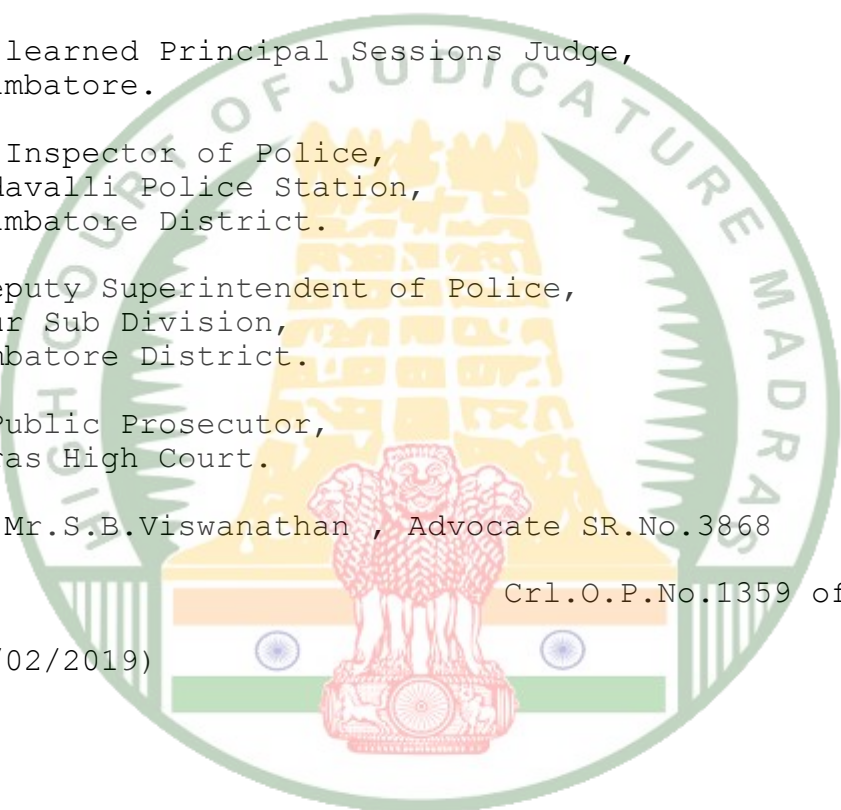
