Petitioner has come up with this Writ Petition challenging the order No.BAP:HR:RMX:LS:123, dated 10.08.2012 and the order No.BAP:HR:RMX:LS:123, dated 18.09.2012 passed by the 3<sup>rd</sup> Respondent and for a consequential direction to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents to consider his representations dated 23.08.2012 and 22.09.2012 and provide employment in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent Undertaking to an eligible member of his family with all attendant service and monetary benefits.
